

# 2024-2025 - International Student Immigration Information and Declaration of Finances - Marine Systems Program

This form is required for students who plan to attend the Northwest School of Wooden Boatbuilding (NWSWB) as a non-immigrant student. In compliance with US immigration regulations, NWSWB can only admit students who have demonstrated proof of financial support for anticipated educational and living expenses incurred during study in the United States. All students who plan to attend NWSWB in M-1 status are required to complete and return this form along with the supporting documents outlined below. When all documentation has been provided, and if there is sufficient financial support, NWSWB can proceed with the Admissions process.

If you will not be financing your own study in the United States, ask your financial sponsor to complete the
Sponsor's Affidavit of Support on page 3.
Provide official documents verifying available funds from your financial institution.
Provide a copy of the biographical (biometric) page of your passport. If you will be travelling with dependents,
also include copies of the passport biographical (biometric) pages for all dependents.
